Lent Course

This Lent there will be the opportunity once again to gather together **in the Rectory** once a week on a **Wednesday evening from 7 - 8.30pm** to talk about following Jesus in the real world. We will be using the book "Lentwise" by Paula Gooder to guide our discussions, but the idea is to learn from each other.

Paula describes her book this way:

"As we journey through life, we face challenges – both big and small. What spiritual essentials will help us survive life's storms? "Lentwise" is a five-session course which helps us to deal with the rigours of real life. Using fresh insights from John's gospel, it explores: direction, nourishment, wisdom, refreshment, and security."
